Results of Web Application Testing Report

Dear Ideiio

This document serves as a formal letter of attestation for **Ideiio's** recent penetration test. UnderDefense has performed a security assessment of the **Ideiio** web application under the auspices of two certified and licensed penetration testers.

As a consequence of successful penetration testing conducted between June 2, 2022 - June 28, 2022, a range of issues was detected:

- 1 medium severity issue
- 2 low severity issues
- 4 informational severity issues

Remediation testing was conducted between **July 20, 2022, and July 26, 2022**, demonstrated that all issues found during penetration testing were properly fixed, except 1 low and 3 informational findings.

The security posture for the **Ideiio** web application is highlighted in the table below. It should be noted that an organization's overall security posture is dependent upon many factors and security is only as strong as the weakest link. The following table is meant strictly as a benchmark for **Ideiio** to compare its current security posture against industry best practices.

Grade	Level	Criteria Description
A	Excellent	The security exceeds "Industry Best Practice" standards. The overall posture was excellent, with only a few low-risk findings identified.
B	Good	The security meets accepted standards for "Industry Best Practice." The overall posture was strong, with only a handful of medium- and low-risk shortcomings identified.
C	Fair	Current solutions protect some areas of the enterprise from security issues. Moderate changes are required to elevate the discussed areas to "Industry Best Practice" standards
D	Poor	There are serious security deficiencies. Immediate attention should be given to the discussed issues to address the exposures identified. Major changes are required to elevate to "Industry Best Practice" standards.
F	Inadequate	There are serious security deficiencies. Shortcomings were identified throughout most or even all of the security controls examined. Improving security will require a major allocation of resources.
