Release Notes for IGA 2023.10.0

This new version of Lifecycle by Fastpath brings major new features, stability fixes and enhancements. All users of previous releases are encouraged to upgrade.

Please review these Release Notes to discover what is new in this version, to find out what you need to know before you upgrade and to review important information regarding known issues and their workarounds.

Major changes and Highlights

Here, we highlight some of the major changes and enhancements introduced by this new version.

- Fixed a problem with the %sponsorname% email template variable not being populated (IGA-5493).
- Fixed an issue that prevented the last updated timestamp being updated.
- (IGA-5488).
- Changing category on the Identity edit page now cause roles to re-evaluate (IGA-4877).

In addition, many minor bugs have also been fixed.

Fastpath will support monthly versions up to a year old. If any changes are required to fix processing or user experience bugs identified, the fix will be made in the latest version and the customer will need to upgrade to get that fix. High priority security vulnerabilities or errors causing system crashes will be fixed in a hotfix version to the version affected.

Installation

Please refer to the Lifecycle Administrator's Guide for full installation instructions.

Upgrading

Always perform a full backup of all installation files, configuration, keys, and database before beginning any upgrade procedure.

It is essential to read this document in its entirety, as well as the release notes for each version between the one you are upgrading from and this one. Each release note outlines the changes that must be made in order to upgrade to that version, as well as the steps that must be completed manually to complete the upgrade and/or maintain your configuration.

Upgrading from any version back all the way to v2.15 (ARMS) and later is supported (sequentially). For versions older than that we recommend upgrading to 2.15 first.

First, install the Lifecycle Package for Debian Linux, following the instructions in the section 'Installing the Debian Package' in the Administrator's Guide.

Next, update the database schema, by running this script:

```
sudo iga-upgrade
```

If you are told that the the schema version could not be determined automatically, (some older releases, for example 3.1.0, cannot), you may need to pass the existing schema version on the command line. e.g.

```
sudo iga-upgrade --existing-schema=3.1.0
```

Next, new privileges may have been introduced, which could restrict both new and existing features. As an administrator you should review Administrative Roles to ensure they continue to meet your requirements.

Lastly, take notice of the following information and follow any special manual upgrade steps documented below. If the section is empty then there are no extra steps for this release, the upgrade is complete.
